

Modifying the RAPT OTG goggle for wider temple prescription glasses.



In some cases the Rapt™ OTG goggle may need to be modified to accommodate for wider prescription glasses.

It's a very simple process that will take just a few minutes.

You will need a marker, a sharp pair of scissors & a friend to score/mark the face foam.



STEP 1.

Place the Rapt goggle over your prescription glasses and adjust the fit of the goggle.

Use a marker to mark where the temple hits the foam.



STEP 2.

Draw the line across the face foam where the temple touches the foam.

Verify the line by holding your glasses next to the foam. Make sure the line is as straight as possible.



STEP 3.

Cut along the line on the face foam. If the scissors don't work then a sharp razor blade will also do the trick.

Be careful not to cut the frame.



STEP 4.

Separate the face foam area to confirm that the cut is deep enough.



STEP 5.

Place the temples inside the foam.

Repeat for the other side. You're ready to go.
